Full Title of Position: Regimental Sergeant Major

Abbreviated Title: RSM

Responsible to: Directly with the Commanding Officer and liaison with Section Heads

The RSM is Responsible for:

- a) The conduct, dress and deportment and attendance of the NCO Corps;
- b) Implementation of the Corps Training Plan, and;
- c) Command and control of Corps Parades.

The RSM's Primary Duties:

- a) Being aware of the corps attendance, whereabouts of Troops and subunits at all times;
- b) Discipline and functioning of the corps;
- c) Ensuring that a high standard of dress and deportment are maintained within the corps through the DSM;
- d) Ensuring that a high standard of drill is maintained within the corps;
- e) Ensuring adherence to the Unit Standing Orders;
- f) Ensuring that safety regulations are adhered to;
- g) Supervision and direction of the Troop Commanders; (and give assistance when needed)
- h) Recommend NCM promotions to the Commanding Officer;
- i) Succession planning for future RSM;
- i) Ensure an accurate parade count is provided to the CO;
- k) Ensuring that all members are within the corps's areas of responsibility and boundaries at all times;
- 1) Preparing the corps for inspection by the Commanding Officer;
- m) Assisting the TrgO in the conduct of training;
- n) Ensure timings for the movement of the corps are strictly adhered to;
- o) Attending O Groups as required;
- p) Conducting NCM briefings on performance, motivation and corrective discipline if required and providing the Commanding Officer with a written report on such events;
- q) Having approving authority for excusing Senior NCMs;
- r) All other duties as assigned by the CO
